

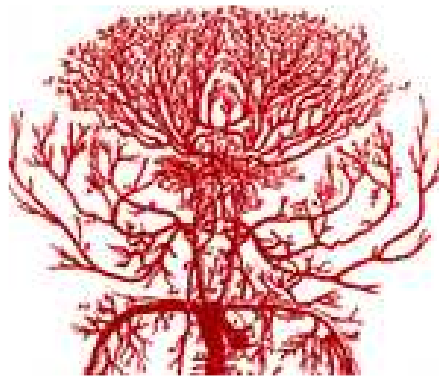

ALICANTE

TRAVEL: Alicante is well connected by direct flights., both regular and charter from many european cities, being the main airport of the beaches of Costa Blanca. Are also excellent connectings flights through Madrid and Barcelona. Highways and railways link Alicante with Madrid and Barcelona. A taxi from the airport to the centre of Alicante needs aprox. 15 min. and cost 15 Euro. Regular flights to Alicante can be very cheap if you reserve it some months in advance. Still cheaper are flights and Hotel as packages offered by tour operators.

WEATHER: Alicante enjoys a mild Mediterranean climate with a microclimate particularly pleasant by the protection from the north winds for a Mountains range. In September the average daily temperature are 20-24 °C and the sea water may be still 18° for bathing.
